

Please read carefully: -

- **All animals for sale must have tested negative for the BVD Virus once in their lifetime, this test can be done anytime from birth.**
- **It is sufficient that an animal tests negative for the BVD Virus one time at any stage in its life (This is where BVD differs from Johnes and IBR).**
- **To minimise test cost the BVD test can be done during your annual herd test.**
- **For BVD it is the animal itself that has to be tested. It is an individual rather than a herd test.**
- **Animals can have antibodies to BVD either through vaccination or exposure to the virus, however this is of no consequence to the animal and does not interfere with the BVD Virus test. The animal must still test to prove it is BVD Virus free.**
- **This declaration must be signed, stamped and dated by your vet.**
